

Public Meeting - 2025 Draft Municipal Budget

A Public Meeting was held to receive comments and input from the public regarding the 2025 draft municipal budget. Council provided notice that it intends to adopt the 2025 budget on **Monday, April 7, 2025**. <u>Draft Budget</u>

Items for Consideration



Centreville Agricultural Society Request for Donation

Council received a <u>Request for Donation</u> from the Centerville Agricultural Society to help with annual expenses and maintenance of the Centreville fairgrounds. Council approved a donation in the amount of \$2,500.00.

Flame Ontario Special Event Permit Application

In recent years, Council has granted approval for an annual arts and culture event hosted by Flame Ontario Arts Collective. In 2024, the event attracted around 900 attendees, boosting tourism in the Township. The event is set to take place from May 15 to May 19, 2025. Council approved the recommendation to issue a Special Event Permit and authorized the Reeve and Clerk to sign a Land Use Agreement in the amount of \$10,000.00. Staff Report

<u>Administrative Monetary Penalty System (AMPS) & By-law Updates</u>

Council received a <u>Staff Report</u> outlining the success of the AMPS By-law, which has been in effect since 2023. The report provided recommendations to apply AMPS to additional municipal by-laws, including, the Dog Licensing By-law 2010-532, Parking By-law 2005-316, Refreshment Vehicle By-law 1998-24 & Fencing By-law 2007-374. Due to the high volume of complaints and inquiries for the Parking By-law and Dog Licensing By-law, public engagement will take place when reviewing these By-laws to ensure transparency and to assist Council implement effective regulatory measures.
