HOW TO STAY INFORMED Based on By-Law 2015-810 By-Law To Regulate The Setting Of Fires In The Township Of Stone Mills.

General Provision States:

No person shall burn prohibited material at any time in the Municipality. Prohibited Material: kitchen refuse, plastics, rubber, tar, shingles, styrofoam, refined paper products, Prohibited Material treated lumber, including creosote, or any other material that during combustion causes the emission of a toxic or noxious gas or smoke into the atmosphere.

Building Or Structure 30.0 meters Forested Area – 30.0 meters Other Combustible Material – 6.0 meters Lot line – 15.0 meters 8.4.5. Overhead wiring – 15 meters Highway – 15 meters 8.4.7. Abutting Dwelling – 75 meters No person shall set multiple brush fires.



No person shall allow a brush fire on a parcel of land that is less than 1.0 hectare in area. No person shall allow a brush fire where the dimensions of the brush fire exceed the following dimensions: Width - 2 meter. Length - 2 meter, Height - 2 meter From April 1 to October 31 brush fires are only allowed from 2 hours prior to sunset to 2 hours after sunrise.

BURN BARREL SET BACKS



Building Or Other Structure – 15.0 meters Other Combustible Material – 3.0 meters Lot Line – 30.0 meters Abutting Dwelling – 75.0 meters Forested Or Wooded Area – 5.0 meters BURN BARRELS

Prohibited on land designated as Hamlet and or a parcel where multiple residential dwellings or multiple residential dwelling units exist. No person shall set a fire in a burn barrel unless the burn barrel includes a metal mesh top with an opening size not greater than 0.5 centimeter.

No person shall set a campfire where the fire exceeds the following dimensions: Width - 1 meter, Length - 1 meter Height - 0.5 meter Only dry Firewood is to be burned.

Building or Structure – 3 meters Other Combustible Material – 3 meters Overhead Wiring – 3 meters Forested Area – 3 meters Highway – 5 meters Lot Line – 5 meters Abutting Dwelling – 20 meters
