Notice of Passing – Interim Control By-Law to Prohibit Cultivation of Cannabis

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Stone Mills, passed By-law No. 2020-1026 on the 13th day of July, 2020 pursuant to Section 38 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990, c.P.13*, as amended.

AND TAKE NOTICE that Interim Control By-law 2020-1026 will be in effect for a period of one (1) year from the date of passing, lapsing July 13th, 2021, but may be extended by Council for an additional one-year period in accordance with Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, or repealed by Council at an earlier date.

Purpose and Effect

The purpose of this By-law is to provide the Township of Stone Mills Planning Department with the opportunity to undertake a land use planning study to examine the land use impacts and methods of regulation of cannabis cultivation, production and processing; and to prohibit any land, building or structure from being used for the cultivation, production, processing or packaging of cannabis or any accessory use associated within the Township of Stone Mills for a period of one (1) year with the possible extension. Further, in accordance with this By-law, the expansion to any existing operation as of July 13, 2020 is prohibited during the duration of the Interim Control By-law.
